The Texas Extension Education Association Clubs of Tom Green County, through the Extension Education Council, offers a three hundred dollar (\$300.00) scholarship to a State University, Junior College or Technical School.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicant must be a Tom Green County resident.
2. It will be given to former Tom Green County 4-H members majoring in any field.
3. New applicants will receive preference over students who have received the scholarship. Undergraduates will receive preference over graduate students.
4. Application forms are available from the Tom Green County Extension Office at 113 W. Beauregard. Completed forms are due in that office before June 1 for the fall semester.

SELECTION:

The Tom Green County EEA 4-H Scholarship committee will make the selection of the recipient from the applications received.

The Scholarship Committee understands that application information **must be kept confidential.**

All applicants will receive a letter in regards to their scholarship status.

AWARDED:

The three hundred dollar (\$300) scholarship will be awarded in August for the fall semester, and in January for the spring semester.
