HAYLEY'S HELPFUL HINTS

With a new 4-H year comes new club meetings, social media campaigns, etc. Have you wondered about the proper way to use the term 4-H or the 4-H logo? Here are some brief hints:

- The numeral "4" should ALWAYS be separated from a capital "H" by the use of a hyphen (-).
- Avoid separation of any of the elements of the 4-H Name at the end of sentences.
- The official 4-H Emblem is a four-leaf clover with "H" in each leaf and the stem turned right, and it can be either two-dimensional or three-dimensional with depth and perspective.

In short, always use "4-H" as specified, ensure the official clover emblem is used correctly, and give credit and follow AgriLife policies for marketing programs.

Also, **prior** to printing out clubs shirts, awards, etc. please share with me so I can make sure guidelines are being followed!

- <u>Swine Validation Tags</u>: If you plan on exhibiting swine at any major stock shows, make sure to get your tag orders in by September 15th to the Extension Office.
- <u>Horse Judging & Hippology:</u> Interested in learning about horse judging or hippology? Make sure to come to the informational on September 19th at 6:00 PM at the Fiesta Building.
